Joshua: The God Who Fights

JOSHUA 10:40–42 1 Joshua subdued them from Kadesh Barnea to Gaza and from the whole region of Goshen to Gibeon. 42 All these kings and their lands Joshua conquered in one campaign, because the Lord, the God of Israel, fought for Israel.

Israel means God fights!



JOSHUA 11:23 3 So Joshua took the entire land, just as the Lord had directed Moses, and he gave it as an inheritance to Israel according to their tribal divisions. Then the land had rest

from war.

GOD HAD KEPT HIS **PROMISES:**

PART 2: A CLARIFICATION ON INTERMARRIAGE, RACISM & GOD'S JUSTICE

God's command against Israel marrying other nations was never about ethnicity or skin color—it was about sin.

GENESIS 15:13–16

"Know for certain that for four hundred years your descendants will be strangers in a country not their own... In the fourth generation your descendants will come back here, for the sin of the Amorites has not yet reached its full measure."

JOSHUA 2:10–11 10 We have heard how the Lord dried up the water of the Red Sea for you when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to Sihon and Og, the two kings of the Amorites east of the Jordan, whom you completely destroyed. 11 When we heard of it, our hearts melted in fear and everyone's courage failed because of you, for the Lord your God is God in heaven above and on the earth below.

"Even the land was defiled; so I punished it for its sin, and the land vomited out its inhabitants." (Leviticus 18:25)

DEUTERONOMY 20:17–18

17 Completely destroy them—the Hittites, Amorites, Canaanites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites—as the Lord your God has commanded you. 18 Otherwise, they will teach you to follow all the detestable things they do in worshiping their gods, and you will sin against the Lord your God.

DEUTERONOMY 9:4-5 4 After the Lord your God has driven them out before you, do not say to yourself, "The Lord has brought me here to take possession of this land because of my righteousness." No, it is on account of the wickedness of these nations that the Lord is going to drive them out before you. 5 It is not because of your righteousness or your integrity that you are going in to take possession of their land; but on account of the wickedness of these nations, the Lord your God will drive them out before you, to accomplish what he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

Step 1: Idolatry



Modern idols aren't carved statues-they're comfort, convenience, career, money, materialism, leisure, relationships, self.

This is how faith dies. Not in a dramatic rebellion, but in quiet neglect.

2 PETER 1:5-8
